Курс: «Английский язык. Практика речи.»

<u>Преподаватель</u>: Кузнецова Наталия Викторовна, кандидат культурологии, старший преподаватель

Читается для студентов 3 курса, обучающихся по специальности «Перевод» Целями и задачами данного курса является повышение общего уровня знания языка у студентов до уровня Proficiency, расширение лексического запаса, освоение навыков применения новой лексики в устной и письменной речи, развитие способности высказываться на различные темы, выражать и обосновывать свое мнение, изучение грамматики соответствующего уровня (proficiency). В задачи курса также входит развитие навыков письменной речи в основных жанрах: письмо, эссе, отчет etc.

В ходе курса обсуждаются темы: Adventure and exploration; People are different; Communication and languages; Food and cooking; Travelling; Money and shopping; The press and current events; Education and studying; Nature and the environment; Books and literature; Science and technology; Relationships; Work and business; Art and entertainment; Health and medicine; History and changes; City life and crime. Каждая тема включает в себя изучение необходимой лексики и грамматики, выполнение заданий на чтение и аудирование, а так же письменных заданий.

Курс рассчитан на 2 семестра. Читается на английском языке.

<u>Итоговый контроль</u>: письменный тест и устный экзамен. Тест состоит из 1 задания на аудирование, 2 заданий на чтение, и 4 заданий на лексику и грамматику по образцу заданий экзамена СРЕ. Вопросы устного экзамена: 1 семестр:
